The Hawaii Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation (www.hlemf.org) was
established in 2010 to honor the ultimate sacrifice of Hawaii's law enforcement
personnel who have died in the line of duty. With the establishment of the
HLEMF, several key milestones have been accomplished. In April 2010, the State
Legislature unanimously passed HCR 139. HCR 139 recognized that Hawaii was
the only state without a law enforcement memorial, that capitol land should be set
aside for its construction, and that the Foundation be the fundraising arm for the
project.

In 2011, HB 1622 (Act 14, SLH 2011) was passed unanimously by both the House and Senate, which provided capitol land on the Diamond Head side of the Kalaimoku Building for the Memorial. Per the Bureau of Conveyances, the parcel is now listed as a Hawaii Law Enforcement Memorial site.

Permitting for construction has been secured with clearances from the Department of General Services (DAGS), the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR), and the City and County's Department of Planning and Permits (DPP). Rights of entry permits from both the city and state have been secured.

A cost analysis by the construction contractor (Designer Built Systems) indicated that total cost to build the Memorial, including materials, would be \$758,000.00.

2. The goals and objectives related to the request;

The goal of this GIA is to secure the necessary funding to finish the design and finally build a long overdue memorial to honor those law enforcement officers who gave their lives in the line of duty. The specific objective is to secure the funds needed to fully construct this memorial; a project that the Legislature and Governor has deemed to be of the upmost importance.

The public purpose and need to be served;

Applicant HLEME

The public should be made aware of the ultimate sacrifice made by too many law enforcement personnel, and to honor those who protect the people of Hawaii on a daily basis.

Describe the target population to be served; and

HLEMF will not only be a memorial for the families of fallen law enforcement officers to visit, but will be a memorial for all Hawaii residents, who have a deep appreciation of the sacrifices made by these individuals, to be able to pay their respects to the fallen.

Describe the geographic coverage.

This memorial, while physically located in Honolulu, will be dedicated to all law enforcement personnel who have lost their lives while in the line of duty, statewide.
