The purpose of Nā Leo Kākoʻo o Oʻahu Inc. is to support the educational activities of Ke Kula Kaiapuni ʻo Ānuenue. Nā Leo Kākoʻo was established by a group of parents committed to ensuring their children be educated in the language of their kūpuna. Initially, the group found themselves fundraising for various huakaʻi (fieldtrips), but that responsibility quickly grew. The need to organize was also fueled by the lack of equity in various areas of their children's public education such as materials production, facilities, transportation and systemic support.

When Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Ānuenue moved to its current campus in school year 1995-1996, the Nā Leo Kāko'o group continued to advocate for educational equity in our public school. We embrace the opportunity to elevate Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Ānuenue for the present and future. By doing so, we can all add in our little ways to support 'ōlelo Hawai'i and to support the 'ike (knowledge) of our kūpuna (ancestors) through immersion education.

It is important to note we are not a charter school.

The goals and objectives related to the request;

The goal of the request is to complete plans for a multipurpose athletic facility for Ke Kula Kaiapuni o Ānuenue. The objective is to give our students equitable opportunity to participate in a safe learning environment for health, wellness, physical education and athletics.

The public purpose and need to be served;

Ke Kula Kaiapuni o Ānuenue is the only high school in the state without a gymnasium or athletic complex. Our athletes shower under a hose, change their clothes in restrooms, and lift weights in classrooms. For example, in order for

students to practice volleyball they have to walk through the Palolo housing complex to Palolo Community Park to use the gymnasium.

- 4. Describe the target population to be served; and Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Ānuenue is a K-12 Hawaiian immersion public school located in Palolo Valley. The student population over the last ten years ranged from 347-403.
- 5. Describe the geographic coverage.

Almost half of the students are bused in from the Leeward coast from Wai'anae and Nanakuli. One fourth of the student population are from central O'ahu, including Moanalua and Kalihi. 71% of all students are bussed into the campus.


