A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SECTION 13 OF ACT 380, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 1997.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 380, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, as
2 amended by Act 3, Session Laws of Hawaii 2001, as amended by Act
3 90, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, and as amended by Act 145,
4 Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is amended by amending section 13
5 to read as follows:

6 "SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect upon its
7 approval [~~; provided that no new safe harbor agreements, habitat~~
8 ~~conservation plans, or incidental take licenses issued pursuant~~
9 ~~to section 195D-4, 195D-21, or 195D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes,~~
10 ~~shall be approved or issued on or after June 30, 2017]~~."

11 SECTION 2. (a) No later than twenty days prior to the
12 convening of each odd-numbered regular session, the department
13 of land and natural resources shall submit a report to the
14 legislature that contains:

- 15 (1) The number and kinds of safe harbor agreements
16 approved pursuant to section 195D-22, Hawaii Revised
17 Statutes; and



1 (2) Summary information regarding the content and
2 performance of each safe harbor agreement identified
3 in paragraph (1).

4 (b) The first report shall be submitted to the legislature
5 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
6 session of 2017.

7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
