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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 216, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, is  
2 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much  
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the  
6 purposes of providing grants and loans for phases II and III  
7 awards[-]; provided that this appropriation shall not lapse at  
8 the end of fiscal year 2015-2016; provided further that all  
9 moneys that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2017, shall lapse as  
10 of that date.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
12 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of  
13 this Act."

14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the  
17 purposes of providing grants and loans for phases II and III  
18 awards.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of  
3 this Act.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2016;  
7 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
