# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MEDICAL ADVISORY BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-4.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established within the office of the state  
4 director of transportation for administrative purposes a medical  
5 advisory board consisting of not fewer than five physicians  
6 licensed to practice in the State. The members of the board  
7 shall be appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34,  
8 except as otherwise provided by this section. The board shall  
9 consist of [~~one psychiatrist, one neurologist, one orthopedic  
10 surgeon, one ophthalmologist or optometrist, and one specialist  
11 in cardiovascular disease.~~] physicians with an interest in one  
12 or more of the following:

- 13 (1) Psychiatry;
- 14 (2) Neurology;
- 15 (3) Orthopedics;
- 16 (4) Ophthalmology or optometry;
- 17 (5) Endocrinology;
- 18 (6) Geriatrics; or



1        (7)    Addiction medicine.

2    The members of the board shall serve without compensation but  
3    shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expense,  
4    actually incurred in the performance of their duties under this  
5    chapter."

6        SECTION 2.    Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7    and stricken.    New statutory material is underscored.

8        SECTION 3.    This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
