A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF HAWAII AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 102-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The bidding requirements of subsection (a) shall not
4 apply to concessions or space on public property set aside for
5 the following purposes:

6 (1) For operation of ground transportation services and
7 parking lot operations at airports, except for motor
8 vehicle rental operations under chapter 437D;

9 (2) For lei vendors;

10 (3) For airline and aircraft operations;

11 (4) For automated teller machines and vending machines,
12 except vending machines located at public schools
13 operated by blind or visually handicapped persons in
14 accordance with section 302A-412;

15 (5) For operation of concessions set aside without any
16 charge;

17 (6) For operation of concessions by handicapped or blind
18 persons; except concessions operated in the public



- 1 schools by blind or visually handicapped persons in
2 accordance with section 302A-412;
- 3 (7) For operation of concessions on permits revocable on
4 notice of thirty days or less; provided that no such
5 permits shall be issued for more than a one year
6 period;
- 7 (8) For operation of concessions or concession spaces for
8 a beach service association dedicated to the
9 preservation of the Hawaii beach boy tradition,
10 incorporated as a nonprofit corporation in accordance
11 with state law, and whose members are appropriately
12 licensed or certified as required by law;
- 13 (9) For operation of concessions at county zoos, botanic
14 gardens, or other county parks which are
15 environmentally, culturally, historically, or
16 operationally unique and are supported, by nonprofit
17 corporations incorporated in accordance with state law
18 solely for purposes of supporting county aims and
19 goals of the zoo, botanic garden, or other county
20 park, and operating under agreement with the



1 appropriate agency solely for such purposes, aims, and
2 goals;

3 (10) For operation of concessions that furnish goods or
4 services for which there is only one source, as
5 determined by the head of the awarding government
6 agency in writing that shall be included in the
7 contract file;

8 (11) For any of the operations of the Hawaii health systems
9 corporation and its regional system boards;

10 (12) For airport operation of concessions providing
11 electronic communication services;

12 (13) For airport operation of concessions consisting solely
13 of advertising;

14 (14) For the stadium authority operation of concessions
15 providing electronic communication services; [~~and~~]

16 (15) For the stadium authority operation of concessions
17 consisting solely of advertising[-]; and

18 (16) For the operations of the natural energy laboratory of
19 Hawaii authority."

20 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016;
2 provided that the amendments made to section 102-2, Hawaii
3 Revised Statutes, by section 1 of this Act shall not be repealed
4 when that section is reenacted on June 30, 2021, pursuant to
5 section 4 of Act 141, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014.
