### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATED TO ELECTIONS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 303 of the Help America Vote Act of 1 2002 requires applicants for voter registration for federal 2 office elections to provide a driver's license number, if one 3 has been issued, or if none has been issued, the last four 4 digits of the applicant's social security number. Section 303 5 also includes a special rule for applicants without a driver's 6 license or social security number, which requires the State to 7 assign the applicant a number that will serve to identify the 8 applicant for voter registration purposes. 9

10 The legislature finds that Hawaii should conform state 11 election law for voter registration to the same requirements of 12 the federal office election law because the voting registration 13 law in Hawaii does not distinguish between voter registration 14 for state and federal offices.

15 The purpose of this Act is to require the applicant's 16 Hawaii driver's license number or Hawaii state identification 17 card number for purposes of identifying an applicant for voter

Voter Registration; Social Security Number; Driver's License Number; State Identification Number

#### Description:

Requires on an application to register to vote, a Hawaii driver's license number or a Hawaii state identification card number or, if no license or identification card has been issued, the last four digits of the applicant's social security number. If the applicant does not have a social security number, requires the State to assign the applicant a unique number for voter registration purposes. (HB1055 HD2)
