
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CANDIDATE COMMITTEE REPORTING DEADLINES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-334, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The candidate and treasurer of the candidate
4 committee of each candidate whose name will appear on the ballot
5 in the immediately succeeding election shall file preliminary,
6 final, and supplemental reports.

7 (1) The filing dates for preliminary reports are:

8 (A) April 1 of an election year;

9 ~~[(A)]~~ (B) Thirty calendar days prior to a primary election;

10 ~~[(B)]~~ (C) Ten calendar days prior to a primary, each
11 special, or each nonpartisan election; ~~[and]~~

12 (D) Thirty calendar days prior to a general election;

13 provided that this preliminary report need not be

14 filed by a candidate who is unsuccessful in a

15 primary, special, or nonpartisan election, or a

16 candidate who is elected to office in the



1 primary, initial special, or initial nonpartisan
2 election; and

3 [~~(C)~~] (E) Ten calendar days prior to a general election;
4 provided that this preliminary report does not
5 need to be filed by a candidate who is
6 unsuccessful in a primary, special, or
7 nonpartisan election, or a candidate who is
8 elected to office in the primary, initial
9 special, or initial nonpartisan election.

10 The preliminary report filed by the date required
11 under subparagraph (A) shall be current through [~~June~~
12 ~~30,~~] March 1, and all other preliminary reports shall
13 be current through the fifth calendar day before the
14 filing deadline of those other preliminary reports.

15 (2) The filing date for the final primary report is twenty
16 calendar days after a primary, initial special, or
17 initial nonpartisan election. The report shall be
18 current through the day of the applicable election.

19 (3) The filing date for the final election period report
20 is thirty calendar days after a general, subsequent,
21 subsequent special, or subsequent nonpartisan



1 election. The report shall be current through the day
 2 of the applicable election. The final election period
 3 report shall be filed by a candidate who is
 4 unsuccessful in a primary, initial special, or initial
 5 nonpartisan election or a candidate who is elected to
 6 office in the primary, initial special, or initial
 7 nonpartisan election.

8 (4) The filing dates for supplemental reports are:

9 (A) January 31 after an election year; and

10 (B) July 31 after an election year.

11 The report shall be current through December 31 for
 12 the report filed on January 31 and current through
 13 June 30 for the report filed on July 31."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.


16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
