## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AERONAUTICS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 261-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) Except as provided in subsection (c), any person  
4 violating this chapter, or any of the rules or orders issued  
5 pursuant thereto and relating to:

6           (1) Safety measures, practices, or requirements;

7           (2) Airport security measures or requirements; or

8           (3) The licensing and regulation of persons engaged in  
9 commercial activities at public airports,

10 duly adopted or served, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor[-];

11 provided that storage of items or materials at airport hangars

12 that do not affect the operation and maintenance of the

13 aircraft, regardless of whether or not those items or materials

14 are required for the operation and maintenance of the aircraft,

15 shall not be deemed a violation pursuant to this subsection."

16           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

Clarifies that storage of items and materials in airport hangars that do not affect the operation and maintenance of the aircraft, regardless of whether or not those items or materials are required for the operation and maintenance of the aircraft, is not a violation of section 261-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
