
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII COUNTY OFFICE OF THE
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$187,118 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2016-2017 for the county of Hawaii office of the prosecuting
6 attorney career criminal prosecution unit, including the hiring
7 of staff.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of
9 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$136,139 or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
14 2016-2017 for the county of Hawaii office of the prosecuting
15 attorney victim awareness assistance program, including hiring
16 of necessary staff.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
