## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO METHAMPHETAMINE TRAFFICKING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 712-1240.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3           "(1) A person commits the offense of methamphetamine  
4 trafficking in the first degree if the person knowingly:

5           (a) Possesses one or more preparations, compounds,  
6 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of one  
7 ounce or more containing methamphetamine or any of its  
8 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers;

9           (b) Distributes one or more preparations, compounds,  
10 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of  
11 [~~one-eighth~~] one-half ounce or more containing  
12 methamphetamine or any of its salts, isomers, and  
13 salts of isomers;

14           (c) Distributes methamphetamine in any amount to a minor;  
15 or

16           (d) Manufactures methamphetamine in any amount."



1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
