
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH, FIFTEENTH, AND SIXTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE
DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the fourteenth, fifteenth, and sixteenth representative
7 districts, as follows:

8 1. To be expended by the department of land and natural
9 resources:

10 A. Waiakaea (Lihi) canal boat ramp and
11 parking lot improvements and Waiakaea
12 canal drainage project, Kauai
13 Plans, design, construction, and
14 equipment for reconstruction and
15 renovation of trailer and vehicle
16 parking lot, boat wash down area, and



1 pavilion; dredge of canal; removal and
 2 replacement of navigational aids.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
16 designated expending agencies for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
