
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) The authority shall employ, exempt from chapter 76
4 and section 26-35(a)(4), an executive director~~[,]~~ and an
5 executive assistant, ~~[a chief financial management advisor, a
6 property management branch chief, a chief planner, and a
7 redevelopment officer,]~~ whose salaries shall be set by the board
8 established under section 356D-3; provided that no salary shall
9 exceed the governor's salary. The authority may employ, subject
10 to chapter 76, technical experts and officers, agents, and
11 employees, permanent or temporary, as required. The authority
12 may also employ officers, agents, and employees; prescribe their
13 duties and qualifications; and fix their salaries, not subject
14 to chapter 76, when in the determination of the authority, the
15 services to be performed are unique and essential to the
16 execution of the functions of the authority; provided that if
17 the authority hires an officer, agent, or employee in a capacity





1 not subject to chapter 76, the authority shall include in an
 2 annual report to the legislature, to be submitted not later than
 3 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session, the
 4 position descriptions and reasons for hiring the personnel in a
 5 civil service exempt capacity. The authority may call upon the
 6 attorney general for legal services as it may require. The
 7 authority may delegate to one or more of its agents or employees
 8 the powers and duties it deems proper."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
