RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

6		and facilities pursuant to section 304A-A for the	
7		preceding three-year period;	
8	(2)	Projected maintenance costs for the proposed building	
9		or facility over its lifetime; and	
10	(3)	The sources of the funding of the proposed new	
11		building or facility, including whether the funds are	
12		from public or private sources."	
13	SECT	ION 2. In codifying the new sections added by section	
14	1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute		
15	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating		
16	the new sections in this Act.		
17	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
18	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
