
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of
2 Hawaii's staff attorneys bear unduly burdensome work caseloads
3 statewide, particularly in contractual matters. The legislature
4 further finds that the provision of additional staff attorneys
5 will result in a more reasonable distribution of workloads, and
6 will therefore lead to more effective legal counsel for the
7 University of Hawaii.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to
9 establish six full-time staff attorney positions (6.0 FTE)
10 within the University of Hawaii system statewide.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
14 University of Hawaii to hire six full-time equivalent staff
15 attorneys (6.0 FTE) to provide legal counsel to the University
16 of Hawaii statewide.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
2 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2525.
