## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 269-91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending the definition of "renewable energy" to read  
3 as follows:  
4           "Renewable energy" means energy generated or produced  
5 using [~~the following~~] sources[+] that include but are not  
6 limited to:  
7           (1) Wind;  
8           (2) The sun;  
9           (3) Falling water;  
10          (4) Biogas, including landfill and sewage-based digester  
11           gas;  
12          (5) Geothermal;  
13          (6) Ocean water, currents, and waves, including ocean  
14           thermal energy conversion;  
15          (7) Biomass, including biomass crops, agricultural and  
16           animal residues and wastes, and municipal solid waste  
17           and other solid waste;

- 2 (9) Hydrogen produced from renewable energy sources[-];
- 3 and
- 4 (10) Other resources that replenish themselves at a
- 5 sufficient rate for sustainable economic extraction in
- 6 meaningful human timeframes."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
