1 "Customized patient medication package" means a package 2 that is prepared by a pharmacist for a specific patient and that 3 contains one or more prescribed solid oral dosage forms. 4 "Institutional facility" has the same meaning as in section 5 461-1. 6 "Pharmacist" has the same meaning as "registered 7 pharmacist" in section 461-1. 8 "Pharmacy" has the same meaning as in section 461-1." 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2070.
