A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MILITARY SERVICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that reserve and national 2 guard members, employed by the State, are authorized to receive 3 fifteen days of annual paid military leave while on active duty 4 or during periods of instruction or maneuvers. However, of the 5 fifteen days, members actually use only about ten to twelve days, leaving the members with three to five days of unused 6 7 military leave every year. Title 5 United States Code section 8 6323(a)(1) authorizes federal employees to use these remaining 9 days for monthly inactive-duty training. There is currently no 10 state statute that allows state employees to do the same. 11 The purpose of this Act is to support reserve and national 12 guard members and to bring state law in conformity with federal 13 law with regard to military leave pay. 14 Section 78-16.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2.

1 "[+]§78-16.5[+] Pay of officers and employees on active 2 military service [-] and other periods. (a) All officers and 3 employees of the State and the several counties who are 4 appointed for at least six months of service shall be entitled, 5 while on active duty, inactive-duty training, or during periods 6 of camps of instruction or field maneuvers as members of the 7 [Hawaii] national guard or [organized reserves, including the 8 officers' reserve corps and the enlisted reserve corps, reserve 9 of the armed forces under call of the President of the United **10** States or the governor of the State, to receive pay as provided 11 by law. During the absence of the officer or employee, while in 12 the performance of ordered military or naval duty, including **13** inactive-duty training, as a member of the national guard[, air 14 national guard, naval militia, or organized reserves, including 15 the officers' reserve corps and the enlisted reserve corps,] or 16 reserve of the armed forces, the officer or employee shall 17 receive the officer's or employee's salary or compensation as 18 [such] an officer or employee, but only for a period not 19 exceeding fifteen working days in any calendar year."
