A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
 to establish a rapid response emergency medical services unit,
- 3 to include personnel, equipment, and operational expenses for a
- 4 twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid response emergency
- 5 medical services unit for the county of Kauai.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to be
- 9 deposited into the emergency medical services special fund.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency
- 11 medical services special fund the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017, to
- 13 establish a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid response
- 14 emergency medical services unit to serve the county of Kauai.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 of health for the purpose of this Act.
