
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
6 ninth representative district, as follows:

7 Department of education

8 1. Kauluwela elementary school, Oahu
9 ADA upgrades for safe wheelchair exit
10 during fire emergencies.

11 Total funding \$375,000

12 2. Farrington high school, Oahu
13 Plans, design, construction, and
14 equipment to convert three rooms in FC
15 building to PE facilities.

2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
