## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RESEARCH CORPORATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF  
HAWAII.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 304A-3005, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§304A-3005 Research corporation excepted from certain  
4 state laws. To carry out the purposes and objectives of the  
5 research corporation, including the conduct of research and  
6 training projects, the research corporation shall be granted  
7 flexibility in hiring its personnel and in handling and  
8 disbursing moneys by being excepted from the following state  
9 laws:

- 10           (1) Sections 36-27 and 36-30, relating to special fund  
11 reimbursements to the state general fund;
- 12           (2) Chapter 103D, relating to advertising for bids and  
13 purchases to be made in Hawaii whenever public moneys  
14 are expended;
- 15           (3) Chapter 103D with respect to construction contracts;  
16 provided that the exception shall not apply where




1 state funds are used and compliance with chapter 103D  
 2 is required by a bill enacted by the legislature;  
 3 (4) Chapter 76, relating to civil service; provided that  
 4 all state agencies shall obtain the prior written  
 5 approval of the governor on a request for, amendment  
 6 to, or supplement to research corporation services for  
 7 a project; and  
 8 (5) Section 78-1, relating to public employment."

9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
