
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read
3 as follows:

4 "PART . LEAN GOVERNMENT ADVISORY BOARD

5 §27-A Lean; definition. As used in this part, "lean"
6 means a business-oriented system for organizing and managing
7 product development, operations, suppliers, and customer
8 relations to create precise customer value, expressed as
9 providing goods and services with higher quality and fewer
10 defects and errors, with less human effort, less space, less
11 capital, and less time than more traditional systems.

12 §27-B Lean government advisory board; established. (a)
13 There is established within the department of human resources
14 development, for administrative purposes, a lean government
15 advisory board, which shall be composed of:

16 (1) The director of each principal department enumerated
17 in section 26-4; and



1 (2) A member appointed by the governor who is familiar
2 with lean principles.

3 (b) The member appointed by the governor shall serve as
4 chairperson of the lean government advisory board.

5 (c) The members of the lean government advisory board
6 shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for
7 expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the performance
8 of their duties.

9 §27-C Lean government advisory board; duties. (a) The
10 lean government advisory board shall apply lean principles to:

11 (1) Analyze current operations and organization of state
12 government;

13 (2) Identify inefficiencies in government operations; and

14 (3) Recommend improvements that will increase government
15 efficiency and improve the delivery of government
16 services.

17 (b) The lean government advisory board shall submit a
18 report of its findings and recommendations, including any
19 proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty
20 days prior to the convening of each regular session."

 2 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
 3 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
 4 the new sections in this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
