1 SECTION 1. Section 383-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§383-24 Maximum potential benefits. The maximum
4 potential benefits of an eligible individual in a benefit year
5 shall be [~~twenty-six~~] fifty-two times the eligible individual's
6 weekly benefit amount."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
