RELATING TO THE DISABILITY COMPENSATION DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
4	department of labor and industrial relations to hire the
5	following six full-time equivalent (6.0 FTE) hearings officer
6	positions and support staff within the department of labor and
7	industrial relations' disability compensation division:
8	(1) One professional employers organization specialist;
9	(2) One vocational rehabilitation specialist;
10	(3) Two disability compensation enforcement specialists,
11	provided that one enforcement specialist each shall be
12	assigned to Kauai and Kona on the island of Hawaii;
13	(4) One auditor; and
14	(5) One hearings officer to be assigned to Kona on the
15	island of Hawaii,
16	and to provide the officers and staff with legal and medical
17	training.
