
RELATING TO AMENDING OR REPEALING HAWAII REAL PROPERTY TAX LAWS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DELETING OBSOLETE OR UNNECESSARY PROVISIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that article VIII,
- 2 section 3 of the Hawaii Constitution provides that the taxation
- 3 of real property in the State has been transferred to the
- 4 several counties. As stated in State ex rel. Anzai v. City &
- 5 County of Honolulu, 99 Haw. 508, 57 P.3d 433 (2002), the need
- 6 for the chapters in the Hawaii Revised Statutes governing the
- 7 taxation of real property in the State lapsed decades ago, and
- 8 those chapters are no longer of any force or effect.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 246, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 3. Chapter 246A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 repealed.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
