## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 342G-82, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:  
3           "(a) Every glass container importer shall pay to the  
4 department an advance disposal fee. The fee shall be imposed  
5 only once on the same glass container and shall not be assessed  
6 on drinking glasses, cups, bowls, plates, ashtrays, and similar  
7 tempered glass containers. For the period beginning [~~September~~  
8 ~~1, 1994,~~] January 1, 2017, the fee shall be [~~one and one-half~~  
9 ~~cents per glass container.~~ ~~Beginning October 1, 2004, the~~  
10 three cents per glass container containing less than two liters  
11 and 4.5 cents per glass container containing two liters or more.  
12 The glass advance disposal fee shall only apply to glass  
13 containers that are not glass deposit beverage containers."  
14           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
