# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MEDICAL ADVISORY BOARD.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-4.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:  
3           "(a) There is established within the office of the state  
4 director of transportation for administrative purposes a medical  
5 advisory board consisting of not fewer than five physicians  
6 licensed to practice in the State. The members of the board  
7 shall be appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34,  
8 except as otherwise provided by this section. The board shall  
9 consist of [~~one psychiatrist, one neurologist, one orthopedic~~  
10 ~~surgeon, one ophthalmologist or optometrist, and one specialist~~  
11 ~~in cardiovascular disease.] physicians with an interest in one  
12 or more of the following:~~

- 13           (1) Psychiatry;  
14           (2) Neurology;  
15           (3) Orthopedics;  
16           (4) Ophthalmology or optometry;  
17           (5) Endocrinology;



1        (6) Geriatrics; or

2        (7) Addiction medicine.

3        The members of the board shall serve without compensation but  
4        shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expense,  
5        actually incurred in the performance of their duties under this  
6        chapter."

7        SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
8        and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
