
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WIRELESS COMMUNICATION SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 440G-8.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Every cable operator shall provide safe, adequate,
4 and reliable service in accordance with applicable laws, rules,
5 franchise requirements, and its filed schedule of terms and
6 conditions of service[-], including but not limited to
7 disclosing to customers and prospective customers the:

8 (1) Minimum average bandwidth that shall be provided; and

9 (2) Maximum bandwidth available,

10 for wireless communication services."

11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13 begun before its effective date.

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.


