A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENFORCEMENT OF WAGE LAWS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 104-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Where the department finds that a first violation of
- 4 this chapter has been committed, the department shall assess a
- 5 penalty equal to ten per cent of the amount of back wages found
- 6 due [or \$25] and \$1,000 per offense[, whichever is greater].
- 7 (b) Where the department finds that a second violation of
- 8 this chapter has been committed, whether on the same contract or
- 9 another[7] contract, within two years of the first notification
- 10 of violation, the department, after proper notice and
- 11 opportunity for hearing, shall order the person or firm in
- 12 violation to pay a penalty equal to the amount of back wages
- 13 found due [or \$100] and \$10,000 for each offense[, whichever is
- 14 greater]."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
