
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish
2 procedures to require a person to present photo identification
3 when using an electronic benefits transfer card.

4 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
6 and to read as follows:


7 "§346- Identification for electronic benefits transfer
8 transactions. The cardholder shall present photo identification
9 to cashiers at food retailers, bank tellers, or other persons
10 authorized to conduct point-of-sale transactions when making an
11 electronic benefits transfer transaction. If no photo
12 identification is provided by the cardholder, the transaction
13 may be declined."

14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
