## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,813,500 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-  
6 ninth representative district, as follows:

7     Department of education

8     1. James B. Castle high school, Oahu  
9         Renovate existing classroom to support  
10        digital media/video productions pathway  
11        and new partnership with Olelo.


8 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
11 provided that all moneys that are unencumbered as of June 30,  
12 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
14 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
15 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of  
16 this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
