# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
3 read as follows:

4           "§27-     Committee on progress of construction projects;  
5 established; powers and duties. (a) The governor shall convene  
6 a committee on progress of construction projects to:

7           (1) Monitor all construction projects of the State for  
8           which at least \$25,000,000 has been appropriated or  
9           projects that are designated as special interest  
10           projects by the governor; and

11           (2) Identify impediments to the progress of those projects  
12           so that those impediments may be reduced or  
13           eliminated.

14           (b) The committee shall monitor each project that  
15 qualifies under subsection (a) (1) and the performance of the  
16 expending agencies, and shall bring any significant project  
17 impediments to the attention of relevant decision-makers so that



1 necessary decisions and other action may be facilitated and  
2 expedited as needed.

3 (c) The committee shall consist of no more than nine  
4 members, who shall be appointed by the governor without regard  
5 to section 26-34. The committee shall elect a chairperson and  
6 one or more vice chairpersons from among its members. The  
7 committee shall be attached to the department of accounting and  
8 general services for administrative purposes.

9 (d) The governor shall convene a meeting of the committee  
10 a minimum of every two months.

11 (e) The committee may require that reports be prepared by  
12 an expending agency in standardized form and review all  
13 documents related to construction projects that qualify under  
14 subsection (a) (1), other than documents that are confidential  
15 pursuant to chapter 92F or as otherwise provided by law.

16 (f) Each agency of the State shall notify the committee of  
17 any construction project that is subject to subsection (a) (1)  
18 and shall cooperate fully in any review of a project by the  
19 committee.



1        (g) The department of accounting and general services  
2 shall bear all expenses of the committee using funds  
3 appropriated for that purpose.

4        (h) Each expending agency shall bear its own costs in  
5 complying with reporting requirements and requests of the  
6 committee."

7        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

8        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
