# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 88, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to subpart C of part II to be  
3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

4 "§88- Retirement benefit incentives for members  
5 separated from service. (a) An active member is eligible for  
6 the temporary retirement benefit incentive established under  
7 subsection (b) if:

8 (1) The member serves in a position that has been  
9 identified for layoff due to the consolidation or  
10 abolition of functions, or the privatization of the  
11 functions of the position as a result of Act 103,  
12 Session Laws of Hawaii 2015; and

13 (2) The member is otherwise eligible for a service  
14 retirement as of the date of application for  
15 retirement.

16 (b) An active member who is eligible under subsection (a)  
17 for a retirement benefit incentive for members separated from



1 service shall receive a retirement incentive of one-twelfth of a  
2 year of additional retirement credit for each year of service  
3 credit earned as of the date of retirement or separation from  
4 service pursuant to subsection (a) (1), up to a maximum of three  
5 years of service credit as of the date of retirement."

6 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030, and  
8 shall be repealed on June 30, 2017.

ERS; Retirement Incentive for Members Separated From Service

**Description:**

Establishes a retirement benefit incentive for public employees, otherwise eligible to retire, whose positions are subject to layoff due to the consolidation or abolition of functions, or the privatization of the functions of the position as a result of Act 103 (2015). Sunsets on June 30, 2017. (HB2606 HD2)
