Section 356D-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Except as otherwise provided, the authority may terminate any lease, rental agreement, permit, or license 4 5 covering the use and occupation of any dwelling unit or other 6 premises located within a public housing project and evict from 7 any premises any tenant, licensee, or other occupant for any of 8 the following reasons: 9 (1) Failure to pay rent when due; 10 (2) Violation of any of the provisions of a lease, rental 11 agreement, permit, or license; 12 (3) Violation of any of the rules of the authority; 13 Failure to maintain the dwelling unit in a clean, (4) 14 sanitary, and habitable condition; 15 Upon a third violation of section 356D-6.5; provided (5) 16 that a violation of any of these terms by a 17 nonresident, a guest who is visiting a resident, or by

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1		any member of the resident's household shall be deemed
2		a violation by the resident; $[\Theta Y]$
3	<u>(6)</u>	Conviction of a felony that is related to the
4		authority's property or fund during the term of the
5		tenancy; or
6	[-(6) -]	(7) The existence of any other circumstances giving
