
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342I-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 "(e) Motor vehicle rental companies shall be permitted to
4 provide a report [~~and payment of the surcharge annually~~], with
5 the year ending December 31, rather than quarterly."

6 SECTION 2. Section 342I-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7 repealed.

8 ~~["§342I-28 Tire inventory records and payment. (a)~~
9 ~~Payment of the motor vehicle tire surcharge shall be made~~
10 ~~quarterly based on inventory records of the importers except for~~
11 ~~those importers subject to subsection (c) or (d). The dates~~
12 ~~September 30, December 31, March 31, and June 30 represent the~~
13 ~~end of each quarter period. All importers shall submit to the~~
14 ~~department documentation in sufficient detail that identifies~~
15 ~~the number of tires imported into the State during the previous~~
16 ~~quarter.~~



1 ~~(b) The amount due from the importers for the quarter~~
2 ~~shall be equal to the number of tires provided in subsection (a)~~
3 ~~multiplied by the motor vehicle tire surcharge of \$1. Payment~~
4 ~~shall be made by check or money order payable to the Department~~
5 ~~of Health, State of Hawaii and shall be deposited into the~~
6 ~~environmental management special fund as provided in section~~
7 ~~342I 29. All subsequent inventory reports and payments shall be~~
8 ~~made no later than the last day of the month following the end~~
9 ~~of the previous calendar quarter, except for those importers~~
10 ~~subject to subsection (c) or (d).~~

11 ~~(c) An importer who imports fewer than fifty tires within~~
12 ~~a one year period shall be exempt from payment of the surcharge.~~

13 ~~(d) An importer who imports fifty or more tires, but fewer~~
14 ~~than or equal to two hundred tires, or a motor vehicle rental~~
15 ~~company shall be permitted to provide a report and payment of~~
16 ~~the surcharge annually, with year ending December 31."]~~

17 SECTION 2. Section 342I-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18 repealed.
