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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$103,481,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth  
6 representative district, as follows:

19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
20 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

1           SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
2 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by  
3 the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

4           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
