## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$80,792,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017  
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
6 the forty-fifth representative district, as follows:

7           1. Kipapa elementary school, Oahu  
8           Plans, design, and construction  
9           to upgrade cafeteria stage,  
10           including ADA-compliant access,  
11           ground and site improvements,  
12           equipment, and appurtenances.

4 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
5 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
10 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by  
11 the department of education for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
