
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATED TO SMOKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 421I, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§421I- Adoption of rules; prohibition of smoking
5 permitted. A corporation may adopt rules to prohibit tenant
6 shareholders, guests, and all other persons from smoking,
7 including but not limited to electronic smoking devices, in
8 dwelling units, common elements, or limited common elements of
9 the corporation."

10 SECTION 2. Section 514B-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

12 "(b) [~~Unless otherwise permitted by the declaration,~~
13 ~~bylaws, or this chapter, an] An association may adopt rules [~~and~~
14 ~~regulations]~~ that affect the use of or behavior in units that
15 may be used for residential purposes only to:~~

16 (1) Prevent any use of a unit [~~which] that violates the
17 declaration or bylaws;~~



1 (2) Regulate any behavior in or occupancy of a unit
 2 ~~[which]~~ that violates the declaration or bylaws or
 3 unreasonably interferes with the use and enjoyment of
 4 other units or the common elements by other unit
 5 owners; ~~[or]~~

6 (3) Prohibit smoking, including but not limited to
 7 electronic smoking devices, by an owner, resident, or
 8 guest in all units, common elements, or limited common
 9 elements as defined in section 514B-3; or

10 ~~[-(3)]~~ (4) Restrict the leasing of residential units to the
 11 extent those rules are reasonably designed to meet
 12 underwriting requirements of institutional lenders who
 13 regularly lend money secured by first mortgages on
 14 units in condominiums or regularly purchase those
 15 mortgages.

16 Otherwise, the association may not regulate any use of or
 17 behavior in units by means of the rules ~~[and regulations]~~."

18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
