
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302D-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Beginning with fiscal year 2012-2013, and each fiscal
4 year thereafter, the non-facility general fund per-pupil funding
5 request for charter school students shall be the same as the
6 general fund per-pupil amount to the department in the most
7 recently approved executive budget recommendation for the
8 department and shall be based upon reasonable projected
9 enrollment figures for all charter schools. The general fund
10 per-pupil request for each regular education and special
11 education student shall:
12 (1) Include all general fund regular education cost
13 categories, including comprehensive school support
14 services, but excluding special education services,
15 adult education, and the after-school plus program;
16 provided that these services are provided and funded
17 by the department; [and]



1 (2) Exclude fringe benefit costs and debt service[-] and

2 (3) Exclude student transportation and meal costs.

3 (b) Fringe benefit costs for charter school employees,
4 regardless of the payroll system utilized by a charter school,
5 shall be included in the department of budget and finance's
6 annual budget request. No fringe benefit costs shall be charged
7 directly to or deducted from the charter school per-pupil
8 allocations.

9 Student transportation and meal costs for charter school
10 students shall be included in the department of budget and
11 finance's annual budget request. No student transportation or
12 meal costs shall be charged directly to or deducted from the
13 charter school per-pupil allocations.

14 The legislature shall make an appropriation based upon the
15 budget request; provided that the legislature may make
16 additional appropriations for facility and other costs.

17 The governor, pursuant to chapter 37, may impose
18 restrictions or reductions on charter school appropriations
19 similar to those imposed on department schools."

20 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
