
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend various
2 session laws to appropriate general funds for raises negotiated
3 or arbitrated on behalf of collective bargaining members and
4 their excluded civil service counterparts who are employed by
5 the Hawaii health systems corporation.
