
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-121, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The board shall consist of nine members as follows:

4 (1) One member from the county of Hawaii;

5 (2) One member from the county of Maui;

6 (3) One member from the county of Kauai;

7 (4) Three members from the city and county of Honolulu;

8 and

9 (5) Three at-large members; provided that the governor
10 shall select an at-large member as the chairperson.

11 The members shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice
12 and consent of the senate. The governor may remove or suspend
13 for cause any member of the board. Of the members appointed
14 pursuant to this subsection, at least one member shall be a
15 former teacher with no less than five years of classroom
16 teaching experience."

17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
