
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2016-2017 as a grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu
6 for the maintenance and repair of the following streets in the
7 96817 zip code:

- 8 (1) The street;
9 (2) Kealakai street;
10 (3) Pala street; and
11 (4) Panui street.

12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the city and
13 county of Honolulu for the purpose of this Act.

14 SECTION 2. The streets listed in section 1 shall be exempt
15 from any statute, rule, ordinance, or code requirement relating
16 to minimum width.

1 SECTION 3. By accepting or expending grant-in-aid moneys
2 appropriated by this Act, the legislature declares that the city
3 and county of Honolulu shall not be deemed to have assumed
4 ownership of or jurisdiction over the streets listed in
5 section 1.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
