A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH CORPS LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many residents of
- 2 Hawaii are increasingly unable to obtain timely and appropriate
- 3 health care due to shortages of primary health care providers in
- 4 the State. These shortages threaten the health of Hawaii's
- 5 residents and affect state health care costs. These shortages
- 6 have pushed the federal government to designate a number of
- 7 areas in the State, particularly rural areas, as medically
- 8 underserved areas, health professional shortage areas, or as
- 9 having medically underserved populations.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the increasingly high
- 11 cost of health care professional education requires individuals
- 12 to seek out the higher incomes that allow them to repay their
- 13 student loans. However, these higher incomes are usually
- 14 acquired in specialty care in urban areas, not in the areas of
- 15 greatest need in Hawaii. Since September 1, 2012, a total of
- 16 sixteen physicians and nurse practitioners have received loan
- 17 repayment to work in health professions shortage areas in Hawaii



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- 1 and are still serving these communities through a loan repayment
- 2 program started by the University of Hawaii John A. Burns School
- 3 of Medicine. The program was started with private donations and
- 4 matching federal funding.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to fund the Hawaii health corps
- 6 loan repayment program under the John A. Burns School of
- 7 Medicine to provide loan repayment for physicians, physician
- 8 assistants, nurse practitioners, psychologists, and social
- 9 workers who agree to work in a federally designated health
- 10 professions shortage area or in an area of Hawaii found to be
- 11 underserved.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2016-2017 for the implementation and administration of the
- 17 Hawaii health corps loan repayment program.
- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the John A.
- 19 Burns school of medicine of the University of Hawaii for the
- 20 purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
