
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PERFORM A
COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF THE KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY ALONG THE
WINDWARD AND NORTH SHORES OF OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, residents and visitors use Kamehameha Highway
2 along the Windward and North Shores of Oahu; and

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4 WHEREAS, Kamehameha Highway is the primary motor vehicle
5 thoroughfare between those two shores; and

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7 WHEREAS, in times when the highway is closed to vehicular
8 traffic, motorists are required to turn around and find another
9 route, which can be a significant inconvenience; and

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11 WHEREAS, commuters and other drivers face significant
12 issues relating to erosion, flooding, parking, and traffic flow
13 on Kamehameha Highway; now, therefore,

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15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
16 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
17 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
18 Transportation is requested to perform a comprehensive study of
19 the Kamehameha Highway along the Windward and North Shores of
20 Oahu; and

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22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as part of its study, the
23 Department of Transportation is requested to:

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25 (1) Include long-term redesign solutions that will
26 mitigate erosion, flooding, parking, and traffic flow
27 issues;

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29 (2) Develop proposed alternate routes; and
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1 (3) Estimate the total costs of an appropriate redesign
2 project; and
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4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
5 Transportation is requested to submit a report of its findings
6 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
7 Legislature no later November 30, 2016; and
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9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
10 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
11 Transportation and the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
