## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CONVENING OF A WORKING GROUP TO CONDUCT A NEEDS-BASED ASSESSMENT OF FARM WORKER HOUSING THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

WHEREAS, affordable housing in general is scarce in Hawaii primarily because of the cost of land and construction; and

WHEREAS, farmers that have long-term agricultural land leases, particularly those which are long-term lessees of agricultural and non-agricultural parks, are frequently unable to provide housing for workers; and

WHEREAS, shortages in adequate farm worker housing reduce the numbers of available farm workers and contribute to increased difficulty for farmers in Hawaii who operate small farms to make their farms sustainable; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Office of Planning, the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority, and the Department of Land and Natural Resources are requested to convene a working group; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to conduct a needs-based assessment of farm worker housing throughout the State of Hawaii; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2017; and
