
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO RENAME A SECTION OF KAPULE HIGHWAY IN
THE COUNTY OF KAUA'I AS THE KAUA'I VETERANS MEMORIAL
HIGHWAY.

1 WHEREAS, military veterans have protected and sustained
2 liberty, freedom, and the American way of life for every citizen
3 of this country since the founding of the United States of
4 America; and

6 WHEREAS, the dedication and sacrifice of the men and women
7 of the United States Armed Forces who have courageously served
8 this country must be honored and not forgotten; and

10 WHEREAS, the sacrifices of those members of the United
11 States Armed Forces who have fallen, been wounded, or are
12 unaccounted for in conflicts with those who would infringe on
13 this country's freedoms and liberties, must be honored and not
14 forgotten; and

16 WHEREAS, it is imperative that the State of Hawaii
17 recognize and honor all veterans of the United States Armed
18 Forces in a tangible, permanent manner that is a constant
19 reminder of their sacrifice, dedication, and service; now,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Governor is
25 requested to take all necessary action to rename and designate
26 the section of Kapule Highway from Rice Street to Ahukini Road
27 in the County of Kaua'i as the Kaua'i Veterans Memorial Highway;

 2 Transportation is requested to erect and maintain the
 3 appropriate signage for the Kaua'i Veterans Memorial Highway; and

 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the renaming and designation of
 6 any section of Kapule Highway as the Kaua'i Veterans Memorial
 7 Highway shall not adversely impact any state or federal funding
 8 for Kapule Highway; and

 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant
 12 Governor, Director of Transportation, Kaua'i County Council,
 13 Mayor of the County of Kaua'i, and Director of Veterans'
 14 Services.
