
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE EQUIPMENT
NECESSARY FOR A FULL-SERVICE CONVENTIONAL KITCHEN AT
KEAUKAHA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND TO PROVIDE NECESSARY
POSITIONS TO OPERATE THE KITCHEN.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Education successfully completed
2 the building of a new cafetorium with a serving kitchen for
3 Keaukaha Elementary School in 2015; and
4

5 WHEREAS, Act 180, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, appropriated
6 \$8,000,000 for plans, design, construction, and equipment for a
7 new cafeteria, ground and site improvements, equipment, and
8 appurtenances for Keaukaha Elementary School on the island of
9 Hawaii; and

11 WHEREAS, most of the Keaukaha Elementary School cafeteria
12 staff positions were moved to another school in the complex area
13 while the new cafetorium was constructed; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the Keaukaha Elementary School and Keaukaha
16 community have continuously requested to have the kitchen be a
17 full-service conventional kitchen and have their kitchen
18 positions returned; and

20 WHEREAS, a full-service conventional kitchen adequately
21 equipped and staffed is necessary for Keaukaha Elementary School
22 and the community it serves; now, therefore,

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
25 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
26 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
27 Education is requested to provide equipment necessary for a
28 full-service conventional kitchen at Keaukaha Elementary School
29 and to provide necessary positions to operate the kitchen; and
