
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO IMPLEMENT THE TRAFFIC SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS IDENTIFIED IN THE KUPUNA LOOP SUB-AREA CORRIDOR STUDY CONDUCTED BY SSFM INTERNATIONAL AND TO REPAVE ALL CITY ROADWAYS IN THE KUNIA AND VILLAGE PARK AREA.

1 WHEREAS, traffic safety concerns voiced by the residents of
2 Village Park in West Oahu, including crash frequency, speeding,
3 reckless driving, and pedestrian safety led to a comprehensive
4 study conducted by the engineering firm SSFM International; and

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6 WHEREAS, the Kupuna Loop Sub-Area Corridor Study analyzed
7 the operational conditions and safety of existing roadways along
8 the entire length of Kupuna Loop, including roads traversing
9 residential areas used to access commercial areas; and

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11 WHEREAS, the Kupuna Loop Sub-Area Corridor Study developed
12 location-specific traffic engineering plans for safety
13 improvements to the area, engineering plans that may provide
14 traffic safety mitigation measures for other communities on Oahu
15 facing similar issues; now, therefore,

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17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
19 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
20 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is
21 urged to work in partnership with SSFM International to
22 implement the traffic safety recommendations identified in the
23 Kupuna Loop Sub-Area Corridor Study and to repave all city
24 roadways in the Kunia and Village Park area; and


