
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO IDENTIFY AND PRIORITIZE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS FOR ALL STATE BUILDINGS BASED ON THE HIGHEST HEALTH AND SAFETY NEEDS.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Accounting and General Services
2 controls and oversees the planning, coordination, and
3 organization of a variety of engineering and architectural
4 services for the State; and

6 WHEREAS, these services include land acquisition and the
7 planning, designing, inspection, and management of construction
8 projects, as well as facilitating quality control, contracting,
9 construction management, equipping of facilities, and other
10 improvements for state agencies; and

12 WHEREAS, every year the Legislature proposes capital
13 improvement projects to address the critical needs of state
14 facilities; and

16 WHEREAS, a prioritization of projects for state buildings
17 by the highest health and safety needs would provide the
18 Legislature with the opportunity to ensure that the focus of
19 funds will go towards the most appropriate facilities; now,
20 therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
25 Accounting and General Services is requested to identify and
26 prioritize repair and maintenance projects for all state
27 buildings based on the highest health and safety needs; and
