
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING GAME MAMMAL, GAME BIRD, AND FISHING RESOURCES IN
ORDER TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABILITY AND FOOD SECURITY AND TO
PRESERVE LONG STANDING LOCAL AND CULTURAL PRACTICES.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii imports between eighty-five and ninety
2 percent of its food, and in the event of a natural disaster or
3 global event that prevents food shipment, Hawaii could face a
4 devastating food shortage; and

5
6 WHEREAS, the practices of fishing and hunting have a long
7 history in the culture of Hawaii; and

8
9 WHEREAS, today, the availability of fresh, locally-caught
10 fish is a basic expectation in our communities; and

11
12 WHEREAS, residents on the island of Molokai receive
13 approximately forty percent of their daily sustenance from
14 subsistence sources such as fishing, hunting, and backyard
15 farming; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the residents of the island of Hawaii harvest up
18 to 1,000,000 pounds of game each year; and

19
20 WHEREAS, game mammals and game birds are a sustainable food
21 source, and our State's unique relationship with the ocean
22 allows us the opportunity to integrate the local fish and game
23 industry into our food security profile; and

25 WHEREAS, policies on conservation and protection of
26 terrestrial and marine resources should promote the concept that
27 game mammals, game birds, and marine resources are an integral
28 part of our island culture; now, therefore,

30 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
31 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular



1 Session of 2016, the Senate concurring, that this body urges the
2 conservation, development, and utilization of game mammal, game
3 bird, and fishing resources; and
4

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body recognizes that
6 pioneered introductions, such as the pig, and later
7 sustainability introductions, such as goats, sheep, and deer,
8 are now recognized as game mammal and game bird resources and
9 should be included among the game management resources supported
10 to achieve sustainability and food security; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body urges state
13 departments to develop and update their rules and policies to
14 integrate the local hunting and fishing industries into any food
15 security or sustainability strategies they employ and to
16 preserve, protect, and promote these industries and local
17 cultural practices to nurture them into viable and sustainable
18 economic, nutritional, and cultural resources; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
22 Board of Agriculture and the Chairperson of the Board of Land
23 and Natural Resources.
